That Jeff Foster video is edited from a longer version. There is also a part 2 and part 3, but I was unable to find them now. In the longer version, once they calm down, Jeff goes on to answer the questions.

Someone I sent this document to didn't understand why they were laughing, so here's an explanation:

Maybe you just had to be there and they both just got the sillies at the same time. However, the first question was "Once the ego is gone, will there be just a spontaneous flow of the universe manifesting?" My understanding of why this broke them up is that (1) "once the ego is gone" never happens because the ego is an illusion, and (2) there is always "just a spontaneous flow of the universe manifesting," i.e., the nondual nature of reality. There can never be anything else. So the questioner misunderstands the nature of reality, and the question is silly. But if you didn't find their laughter contagious, I don't think that explanation will help you to laugh.

Laughter tends to be contagious, whether or not people understand why they are laughing. In the video with Jeff Foster, you can hear the camera woman also laughing, and in the three videos with Mooji below, the other people in attendance also laugh.

I certainly do not claim to be "awake," but I understand that once you have an insight into the nature of reality, all the intellectualizing questions and doubts and concerns about the self and oneself appear to just be silly, so that "all that's left is to have a good laugh."
